

7 THINGS I PRAY *Over My Adult Children*

1 I pray that they will grow to know Jesus Christ personally, completely, and intimately.
"I am the Good Shepherd. I know My own and My own know Me." John 10:14

2 I pray that they will understand the power of these verses, and claim them over their life.
"For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:38-39

3 I pray that their lifelong journey of faith finds them only in the very center of God's will.
And that they will find peace and contentment nowhere else but there.
"Make me to know Your ways, O Lord; teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; for You I wait all the day long." Ps. 25:4-5

4 I pray that they will never look for these things (peace and contentment)
in what the world has to offer them.
"But godliness with contentment is great gain, for we brought nothing into the world, and it is certain that we cannot take anything out of the world. But if we have food and clothing, with these we will be content." 1 Timothy 6:6-8
